#### **Classroom Management Plan**

A. <u>Course Overview:</u> Introduction to Filmmaking and Video Production is a Full-year course that offers students the fundamentals of film and video production. Through a series of written, produced, and presented assignment work, the students will examine theory and attain hands-on production experience to learn what it takes to make motion pictures. With emphasis on writing, directing, sound, cinematography, editing, producing, and the other various aspects of film, movies and video production students will learn all the aspects of production: development, pre-production, production and post production.

## **B.** Student Requirements:

A **three ring binder** is required. The student must always have paper and a pen or pencil to take notes. Coming to class unprepared to take notes will affect your preparedness grade.

Assignments and their due dates will be available in class or on line. Please check with instructor if you have any questions. If you are absent it is your responsibility to find out what you missed.

\*Donations will help build our program. A modest donation of \$47 is requested to cover video tapes and equipment usage. Since the video program uses expensive and sensitive equipment, maintenance will be required to keep the program running.

### C. Student Behavior Responsibilities:

NO inappropriate clothing, hoods, or sunglasses.

NO Music Players or cell phones will be allowed during class time. No headphones. These rules may be flexible if explicit permission from the instructor is given.

Students will be excused from any late assignments only with a signed note from a parent or guardian.

All missed work will be expected to be made up or a zero will be given.

All assignments must be turned in on time, neat and with the student's name on it. Late assignments will be docked a letter grade for each day they are late.

The consequence for violating any of the above rules could result in one hour of detention, Saturday School or expulsion from the program depending on the severity of the violation.
